The Biden Dilemma

America, we have a problem. I call it the Biden Dilemma.

What, pray tell, is the Biden Dilemma?

I'll tell you soon. But first we have to take the long way around. I'm going to discuss competing systems of Presidential elections—the American Constitutional approach and the Parliamentary approach. It matters.

Ever since I was old enough to understand civics and politics, I have been a big fan of the United States Constitution. I'm particularly enamored with the genius of our Presidential elections. The two questions that immediately come to mind are: What's the difference and why is ours a better system. The answer in a nutshell: The Electoral College. The Democrats often talk about getting rid of the Electoral College and just leaving one vote count instead of fifty. They forget about the law of unintended consequences. The Electoral College is the glue that holds the two-party system together. Take away the Electoral College and new parties form overnight, depriving the leading candidate of a majority of the (former) electoral votes or the raw vote count. Where did those votes go? On the left they went to the Greens, the Socialists and the Ecopolos. On the right they went to the Libertarians, the Evangelicals and the Bizpackers. We don't have that. We have big tents. AOC and Joe Manchin share a party. So do Donald Trump and Liz Cheney. You get the idea. Therefore, almost all Presidential elections are quickly decided by a majority of electoral votes. Along the way the primaries are intraparty fights for control of the message. But the general elections are a race to the middle, as "Independents" and swing voters determine the outcome. This is a good thing.

Now consider the Parliamentary process. Often, there is no party that has a majority of elected Congressmen (or Members of Parliament). The party with the greatest plurality attempts to form a government. In other words, the center asks the extremes to coalesce to get over the fifty percent plus one bar. The extremes demand a price—issues that are near and dear to them. Get it? The minor parties are big time lobbyists. And here's the coup de grace: If at

any time they don't feel loved enough, they can pack up their seats and leave. That breaks the majority and literally brings down the government.

And that brings us full circle. What is the Biden Dilemma? It's our inability to get rid of this massively failing President with another three years to go. Understand, if we were a Parliamentary government with a coalition administration, at least one of the minor parties within the coalition would have pulled out already. We would have no ruling government with elections right in front of us. Bye, bye Biden.

A Presidential system has no such safety valve. But, but, but you say: What about Impeachment and the 25th Amendment? Bogus, I say. Our country is on its 46th President and we have never removed any of them via the Impeachment process. Yes, Richard Nixon would have been the one had he not resigned. But that was before the Republicans knew the rules of the game. What rules? The ones that say that no Democrat would ever vote to impeach another Democrat. A Democrat could have extramarital sex in the Oval Office, lie about it on national television and still not get a single Democrat to vote for Impeachment. A Democrat could abandon a war zone, leave thirteen dead soldiers on the way out, abandon sixty-five billion dollars' worth of our most technologically advanced weaponry to the enemy and know that not a single Democrat would vote to impeach. Bogus, I say.

And the 25th Amendment, you ask? Donald Trump is the Energizer Bunny. And he has the mental acuity tests to prove it. Joe Biden? Not so much. Yet the Democrats allegedly considered wiring an FBI guy to record Trump to make a 25th Amendment case for removal. Joe Biden has no such worry. In an administration where every day is Weekend at Brandon's, no Democrat would dare act on the obvious. Sadly, the 25th Amendment is just another weapon for Democrats to use to torture Republican Presidents.

And therein lies the Biden Dilemma. We're stuck with him for another three years; for another half-million COVID deaths, for more Russian incursions, for the scourge of inflation, for open borders, for the paucity of energy, for the encroachment of China, for the boys beating up on the girls. And there's nothing we can do about it.

We just knew we were part of something new, big and game-changing. I call it: MULTICULTURAL ASSIMILATION. I’m ready for next year’s event—after the November elections.

The Democrats always play the long game. The Progressive movement rose to prominence in 1912. In that Presidential election year, Progressive Teddy Roosevelt lost to Progressive Woodrow Wilson. Wilson’s first year in office, 1913, saw America’s first national income tax and the brand, spanking new Federal Reserve. The Election Fix—Update

MARCH 29—This came out yesterday—more evidence that the 2020 presidential election was the biggest election heist in history:

From *The Washington Times*:

President Biden received hundreds of thousands of “excess” votes in Democrat-controlled areas in the 2020 election, according to an academic study on voter fraud that suggests the push to relax voting standards created new opportunities for electoral mischief.

John R. Lott Jr., the man behind the research, teased out those numbers by comparing Democrat-dominant areas to Republican-dominant places over the past two presidential elections, particularly in places where claims of election fraud were reported in 2020.

Looking at six swing states, the data he crunched found that voter turnout in Republican areas increased from 2016 to 2020 while voter turnout among Democrats dropped—except in places where voter fraud was claimed.

That accounted for 255,000 “excess” votes for Mr. Biden above what would be expected, Mr. Lott said. His paper has been accepted for publication in *Public Choice*, a peer-reviewed journal specializing in the intersection of economics and political science.

“More heavily Democratic counties actually had a slightly lower turnout in 2020, except for counties where vote fraud was alleged. In those counties, you had a huge increase in turnout,” Mr. Lott told *The Washington Times* in an interview explaining his findings.

60 Years Later and the Military/Intelligence Complex Is Still the Enemy of the People

MARCH 22—When I was a senior in college as a political science major, I wrote my senior thesis which focused on the assassination of John F. Kennedy.

I concluded that elements within the United States government may well have been involved in the assassination and certainly were involved in the cover-up including the bogus Warren Report.

Seems like not much has changed in 60 years since Kennedy was gunned down in broad daylight, being hit in the frontal lobe of his head as well as from behind.

Keep in mind this was written October 19, 2020, five days after *The Post* published its first story. Neither Joe Biden nor Hunter Biden had denied the story, they simply deflected questions. Didn't these security experts think that if this was disinformation, the Biden campaign would have yelled to the heavens that the story was false?

Politico picked up the letter and ran the false headline “Hunter Biden story is Russian disinfo, dozens of former intel officials say.” That headline is still online today, even though the letter clearly says they don't know if it's Russian disinformation.

That headline was tweeted out by legions of Democrats, including current White House spokeswoman Jen Psaki, as proof that it was all a con. That tweet also is still up despite being proven false.

Thus pure speculation by a group of biased officials became gospel among the media. This was “fake news,” and could be safely ignored.

Keep in mind that Twitter already had banned *The New York Post* a few days before. The rationale was that this was “hacked materials,” even though it wasn't—and Twitter had no evidence to think it was. A Facebook official, mean-

I'll warn you; this plan is not for the faint of heart.


It will be ridiculed by the 'woke' left, mocked by Washington insiders, and strike fear in the heart of some Republicans. At least I hope so.

I got an email recently from the congressional representative of District 21, where I've lived since 1973. Rep. Lois Frankel warned in that urgent message that, "the Supreme Court allowed a dangerous Texas abortion law." Of course, abortion is dangerous—to innocent babies as well as to many women suffering from botched abortion operations.

So, she joined with Rep. Judy Chu in introducing federal legislation—titled the Women's Health Protection Act—that "would protect health care providers" that commit abortions to be "free from medically unnecessary and onerous restrictions, such as waiting periods, or unnecessary ultrasounds."

Abortion is the killing of a preborn human being with a beating heart. In just months that baby would be an American citizen. And our representative in Congress thinks that precious little life is meaningless. 

The 1965 Civil Rights Act—Contrary to myth, Republicans supported this law much more than did the Democrats. In the Senate, 94% of Republicans voted in favor, while just 73% of Democrats voted for it. In the U.S. House of Representatives, 82% of Republicans voted in favor, compared to 78% for the Democrats. Senator Everett Dirksen (R-IL), co-author of the 1965 Voting Rights Act (VRA), helped outmaneuver Democrat opposition: "There has to be a real remedy. There has to be something durable and worthwhile. This cannot go on forever, this denial of the right to vote by ruses and devices and tests and whatever the mind can contrive to either make it very difficult or to make it impossible to vote," he declared. The 1965 VRA achieved for African-Americans a major goal of the GOP's Reconstruction Era civil rights agenda, which the Demo-



crats had blocked a century earlier. Yet, to this day, the Democrats get the credit for passing the 1965 civil rights bill because they had a Democrat president in office at the time. Our leaders have rarely made it clear how we felt and voted on this issue, so the left gets to claim another Republican-inspired, and Republican-backed, issue.

There are many more examples of the left robbing us at gunpoint, but in all of the cases, including these two, the left has taken credit for something our side initiated and we allowed them to get away with it. It appears that Juneteenth will be snatched from us as well, as we, those on our side, debate what is and what isn't, should we celebrate or shouldn't we. The reality is this: in light of the failures of our party leadership, our party has done more for Blacks and the downtrodden in this country than any other political party can boast, yet our leaders do not talk this up or promote what we are about. The Biden Administration's False Narratives and Web of Lies

The Case for Energy Independence

Background

At the end of the Trump presidential term the U.S. had achieved energy independence, this for the first time in sixty years. This meant that we no longer had to import oil or natural gas from foreign countries to satisfy our energy requirements. In fact, we had become an energy exporter. We were exporting liquified natural gas (LNG) to our allies, particularly in Western Europe. Oil company explorations had also confirmed that oil reserves in both Canada and the U.S. exceeded the combined reserves of Saudi Arabia, Russia, and Venezuela. This meant lower energy prices in the U.S. and no dependence on foreign actors for energy. At the end of the Trump administration the national average for a gallon of gas at the pump was \$2.10 per gallon. We were also instrumental in blocking completion of the Nord Stream pipeline from Russia into Western Europe. This pipeline would have increased dependence on Russia for energy and given Russia financial and political advantages in European politics.

During the first months of the Biden administration our energy independence was cancelled. The Keystone XL pipeline extension was cancelled on day one. This was followed by cancellation of further drilling in the ANWAR section of Alaska and on other public lands in the U.S. Restrictions and regulations were placed on oil and gas companies that raised production and distribution costs by millions of dollars. As a result, the U.S. was forced to meet energy requirements by buying oil and gas from foreign nations, particularly Russia. In one year the price of gas at the pump increased to an average of \$3.60 per gallon—an increase of 71 percent. The price of natural gas for industrial and home heating use increased by close to 100 percent. The Biden administration also removed any objections to the Russian Nord Stream pipeline.

Analysis

The U.S. has moved from a net energy exporter to a net energy importer. The price of energy for private and industrial use has increased dramatically with no end in sight. The loss of hundreds of thousands of energy related jobs is significant. The costs of production and distribution for energy-dependent companies has ballooned, particularly for over-the-road trucking which delivers the huge majority of goods from the producer to the consumer. The consumer pays for the gas used by these trucks.

But oil and gas isn't just used to fuel our cars, heat our homes, and fly airplanes. Close to 50 percent of oil consumed in this country is used to produce products we touch

and use every day. The asphalt we drive on is made of oil. The tires rolling on that asphalt are made from oil. Plastics are made of oil. Synthetic fabrics used to make our clothing are made from oil. Oil is even used in the manufacture of some things we eat. Every day we touch and use hundreds of things either made from or dependent on oil and gas.



We have moved from a position of global energy dominance to a position of dependence. We are once again at the energy mercy of foreign actors who use energy as a political and territorial aggression tool. The brazen invasion of Ukraine by Russia is a case in point. Energy exports account for over 47 percent of the Russian economy. Our removal of U.S. energy from the world supply has increased European dependence on Russian energy and has raised the price of energy on a worldwide basis. Consequently, Russian energy income has increased dramatically along with the political lever of energy dependence. We are now in the ridiculous position where Russia is paying for the Ukraine invasion with energy income from the U.S. and other adversaries who, at the same time, condemn the invasion. The implied Russian threat of cancelling the energy flow to energy-dependent NATO countries has weakened NATO's response to the Russian invasion.

Motivations

The current situation begs the question, "Why have we cancelled energy independence?"

Why would Biden cripple our energy industry, visit financial hardship on our country, and weaken our leverage in the international arena? I suggest three reasons.

1. Green New Deal, Global Warming

One obvious and perhaps the primary reason is to satisfy the Green New Deal and Global Warming ideologues. If we cripple our fossil fuel energy production wouldn't this reduce the amount of gas and oil used in this country and then the world? The answer is "No." If we can't get gas and oil here, we will import it from abroad. There will be no net reduction in usage. The world market will supply all the oil and gas we need but at higher prices. Note that Canada, the primary supplier of oil to the cancelled Key-

stone XL pipeline, will now sell this oil to China and other users of heretofore available U.S. energy.

2. Environmentalists

Another reason is to satisfy environmentalists. Their claim is that pipelines break and spill, they destroy the landscape, and ruin the local ecology. These claims are grossly overstated and easily disproven. The fact is that pipeline delivery of oil is much more environmentally friendly than rail car, over the road, and ocean tanker delivery. Witness the black diesel clouds coming from diesel electric locomotives and eighteen wheelers. What about tanker spills into our oceans and oil car train wrecks?

3. Globalism

Another compelling reason comes from the Globalists. They don't believe in the dominance of any country in any meaningful activity. They want to reduce the "America First" dominance of this country into a "One Among Many" stature. One of the ways to promote global equity, fairness, and social justice is for a central group of elitists, authoritarian rulers, and international companies to distribute wealth and happiness on an equal basis around the world as determined by those few intelligent enough to recognize and solve the world's problems. Clearly one of the obvious targets in this Globalist scheme is our energy dominance.

Action Item

Should we allow the supposed threat of the seas rising one-half inch in the next eighty years to destroy our energy independence? On a more immediate basis, should we allow this supposed global warming catastrophic future event to prevent us from countering the Russian invasion of Ukraine? Short of armed intervention, the most effective tool that we and Western Europe have is the destruction of the Russian economy. Given this, the Russian war effort would lose funding and the population might rise up and get rid of Putin. The most effective tool in this effort, the one that would cripple 47 percent of Russia's economy, would be to cut off all energy imports from Russia, both here and abroad. But then what about our and Europe's dependency on Russian energy? Easy. Restore the proven energy independence here and send our energy excess to Europe. Are you listening, President Biden? In the meantime, China sits back, smiles, and watches our ineffective response to territorial aggression.

Biden's New Deal With Iran Threatens Security of Whole World

And why is our incompetent, Secretary of State, Anthony Blinken, still relying on Iran to keep its promises in a new deal when only a few weeks ago Iran’s Revolutionary Guard took credit for the rocket attack on a U.S. base in Erbil, Iraq? Its goal . . . to kill Americans. A thumb in the eye to us. This deal extension, with added benefits to Iran, would be an unmitigated disaster. And contrary to White House “pie in the sky” dreams, Iran has no intention of ever giving up its ambition to become a nuclear power. A threatening one to the world, at that.

A refreshed deal, like the 2015 one it would replace (that was thankfully canceled by President Trump in 2018) would continue to have a flawed inspection system. The reality is that the new Biden deal would enable Iran to become a nuclear threshold state within a maximum of three years. By then it would have enough enriched uranium to make numerous bombs. It also has other disturbing flaws such as permitting the ayatollahs to get their murderous hands on nearly 100 billion bucks in foreign currencies. It will enable the regime, repeatedly listed by the U.S. as a state sponsor of terrorism, to have full nuclear weapons capability, an unlimited number of nuclear warheads, and the intercontinental ballistic missile systems with which to deliver them. In addition, as a separate deal, the U.S. will reportedly release the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) from our list of foreign terrorist organizations. This would be to Iran, a Muslim Christmas present.

It as well, says nothing about that nation’s proxy terrorist militias, Hezbollah in Syria and Lebanon and the

Houthis in South Yemen. And please keep in mind that the negotiations between us and Iran have Russia and China as intermediaries . . . supposedly on our side. Repeat—”China and Russia are negotiating for us.” As unthinkable as having the Taliban protect U.S. troops in Afghanistan which resulted in our disastrous withdrawal from that country with 13 dead U.S. military and a still unknown number of Americans left to the mercy of the Taliban. Unbelievable, but in a Biden world, all is possible. Forty nine U.S. Republican Senators on March 14, 2022 sent out a statement to Biden that they will not back this new deal warning about these negotiations. They told the president: “By every indication the Biden Administration appears to have given away the store. The nuclear limitations in this new deal appear to be significantly less restrictive than the 2015 nuclear deal, which was itself too weak and will sharply undermine U.S. leverage to secure an actually longer and stronger deal. What is more, the deal appears likely to deepen Iran’s financial and security relationship with Moscow and Beijing, including arms sales.” So, keep in mind that the Republicans in Congress, if they take over numerically in this years election, whatever agreement Biden makes will be dead in the water.

But how would this new deal impact and threaten Israel and other nations in the Mideast? We fear the current Prime Minister of Israel, Naftali Bennett, is no stronger or better than Biden in preventing Iran from dominating the Mideast with its soon to be nuclear arsenal. Just this week, Israel’s Foreign Minister Yair Lapid announced that cooperation among the U.S., Morocco, Egypt, Bahrain and the United Arab Emirates will continue on a regular basis in order to stoke fear in Iran and stem their imperialist efforts. Good luck! In his talk at the two day Negev Summit that was held with his counterparts from Abraham Accords nations alongside the U.S. and Egypt in Sde Boker, he said the meeting was “the first of its kind, but not the last. “Last night we decided to make the Negev Summit a permanent forum.” These meetings would focus on the threats to the region from Iran. All empty talk. They play “Follow the leader,” with Biden in charge. We are concerned that PM Bennett is too dependent on the Biden administration to subdue the aims of Iran to become a threatening nuclear state. His predecessor Netanyahu was a hawk on this issue and constantly warned Iran and the U.S. that Israel would take all measures into consideration to make sure Iran would not become nuclear. He was forceful, decisive and there was every indication he would act without U.S.


“For God’s sake, this man cannot remain in power,” Biden said, in an unscripted remark that came at the end of his roughly 30-minute address.



Hidden History

Dr. Mary E. Walker: The Sole Female Medal of Honor Recipient

In honor of Women's History Month, we're traveling back in time to 1861 and the start of the Civil War. This period in history is when Dr. Mary Edwards Walker helped change the face of medicine and was awarded the Medal of Honor.

Out of about 3,500 Medal of Honor recipients, Dr. Mary Walker remains the only female to receive the award. Walker's medal was rescinded before she died and later reinstated, but first, let's share the incredible story on the imprint she left in American history.

Born in Oswego, New York, Walker grew up in a progressive household with parents who encouraged independence, education, and justice, especially for women's rights. Embracing her upbringing, Walker became determined at a young age to defy traditional feminine standards on a principle of injustice. From the clothes she wore to the work she performed, Walker often encountered criticism because she was everything a 19th-century woman was not. Never wavering, Walker saved enough money to pay her way through college, and in 1855, she graduated with honors from Syracuse Medical College, the only female medical doctor in her class.

Walker joined private practices for a few years before the Civil War broke out in 1861. Eager to join the war to serve as a surgeon for the Army, she traveled to Washington, D.C., where she met with disapproval simply because she was a woman. To no surprise, Walker did not take no for an answer.

Against All Odds

Instead of packing her bags and returning home, she decided to seek other options by traveling from hospital to hospital to volunteer her services. She was offered the role of a nurse but declined knowing she had the credentials to be a surgeon. So instead, she asked to volunteer for the Union Army. The Army had no female surgeons at the time, and, at first, she was only allowed to practice as a nurse. All she asked for in lieu of money was a place to sleep.

She served in many battles where she treated the severely wounded in makeshift hospitals, including serving in the first major battle of the war, First Battle of Bull Run, in 1861. Later, she continued working unpaid at the Patent Office Hospital in Washington, and near the Union front lines, including the Battle of Fredericksburg. In 1863, Walker was finally appointed a paid position as the first female surgeon of the U.S. Army and served as a civilian-contracted assistant surgeon of the 52nd Ohio Infantry.



Here, Walker frequently crossed battle lines into enemy territory to treat civilians who hadn't received medical care in a long time. This act alone put her at great risk, especially because Walker would often be on her own. She would use this alone time to listen for any information on troop movements and bring the intel back to her commanding officer.

In April 1864, while on one of her journeys to help others, Walker was captured by Confederate troops and arrested for spying, although never admitting to it. As a prisoner of war, she was sent to several female military prisons for the next four months. Unfortunately, her health declined severely while in prison, ultimately damaging her lungs and eyes so badly that she couldn't practice surgery again. Eventually, Walker gained freedom through a prisoner exchange.

Military's Top Honor

After the war ended, Walker desired to be a commissioned officer to validate her years of service. However, up to this point, there was no precedent for commissioning a woman. Thus, President Andrew Johnson instead awarded her with the Medal of Honor in November of 1865.

The terms of the Medal of Honor were broader then than they are today, which caused a lot of ambiguity. Walker opened the flood gates for fellow service members to write their congressman stating that they also deserved the award, which caused the military to create parameters around eligibility and requirements. By 1917, a review of the Medal of Honor awards resulted in 911 individuals being stripped of their award—including Walker.

Refusing to return the medal, Walker wore it every day until her very last on Feb. 21, 1919. It wasn't until 60 years later, with the help of her descendants, that Walker's medal was restored by President Jimmy Carter in 1977.

Today, her hometown features a life-size statue of Walker and a state senate proclamation declared May 12 as Dr. Mary E. Walker Day in Oswego. George DeMass, the Oswego town historian, played a role in making this commemoration happen.

"I was fortunate to know people who knew her," DeMass said. "Ten years ago, we dedicated the statue, and last year, we decided to hold an impromptu ceremony for Medal of Honor Day. I realized then that this statue really brought her back to life."

The Will and Resolve of 30 Republican Governors




Postscript

Tom Mullings, R.I.P.

Thomas Erick Mullings was the proud editor of this newsletter for more than six years. As many of you already know, he passed away in October of last year at the age of 73 after being in declining health for nearly two years. He took his position as newsletter editor very seriously, and as his health deteriorated, putting together a newsletter each month gave him purpose and kept him going. He was an avid reader, reading everything from astronomy and paleontology to history and politics. He read a biography of every president from George Washington to Donald Trump. It was a joy for him to be able to review a book in these pages every month.

Tom’s passing has left a void that will be hard to fill. Palm Beach County GOP Chair Michael Barnett is in the process of lining up a new editor, and in the meantime I am putting this issue together for April.

Tom and I met in late 1969, not long after he had been discharged from the Army. He had been drafted in 1967 and was sent to Vietnam, where he volunteered to be a scout dog handler. Although this was an extremely dangerous job as it meant walking point for an infantry unit, he liked the idea of having a dog in the field. He was assigned to the 39th Scout Dog Platoon of the 173rd Airborne Brigade and was based in Qui Nhon in the Central Highlands. After three months in Vietnam, he was shot in an enemy ambush, receiving what was known as a “million-dollar wound”—one that was serious enough to get him sent back to the States but not bad enough to cause him permanent disability. The bullet that shot him, from a North Vietnamese AK-47, was taped to his chest when he awoke after surgery, and I still have it. Tom spent six months in the hospital and on convalescent leave and was returned to active duty in Fort Benning, Georgia, where he trained soldiers

headed for Vietnam to be scout dog handlers. The Army awarded him the Purple Heart and the Army Commendation Medal, among other medals.

In 1979 he and his friend Jan Scruggs, also a wounded Vietnam veteran, began the process of creating a memorial to Vietnam veterans, and after getting various approvals from Congress, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial was dedicated on the DC Mall in November 1982, next to the Lincoln Memorial. It has become one of the most visited monuments in the Nation’s Capital.

Tom was a rarity—someone who was actually born in Washington, DC, as was his father. Tom was raised in the Hollywood section of College Park, Maryland, where his father owned a Sunoco gas station across the street from the University of Maryland. He leaves two brothers, Gary and Mark; two nieces, Becky Crosetto (Andres) and Jennifer Griffith (Geoffrey); two nephews, Tommy (Alexis) and Gary; four great-nieces, Annaliese, Sienna, Whitney and Rory; and a great-nephew, Gary. Tom and I were together for 51 years and we moved to Florida in 1989.

Tom was buried with full military honors in Arlington National Cemetery on December 27, replete with a seven-gun salute, the playing of Taps, and the folding of the flag that draped his casket, which was presented to me. It was his wish to be buried in Arlington, where his grandfather is also buried, and I was honored that he was accepted to be there, as space is limited. It was a very moving ceremony, and the cemetery was beautiful, with wreaths laid on every grave, lovingly placed there by Wreaths Across America.

Above all else, Tom was a patriot. He loved his country, cherished his family and his golden retrievers Abby and Chrissie, and will be missed. He left us much too soon.
